## An Unearthing

The text is taken from the first book of Virgil's Georgics (with many thanks to the suggestion from Patrick Swanson) and is the first composed of a planned set.

*Be sure of this: the time will come, when in those fields,  
the farmer working the earth with curved plough,  
will unearth rough weapons eaten by rust,  
or strike the side of an empty helmet with his heavy hoe,  
and wonder at the bones of great ones now untombed.*

Womens' or childrens' voices may double the melody at the octave but lightly so as not to overwhelm the modest character

Optional parts for percussion (bamboo clappers, cowbell, anvil, ranch triangle and chinese opera gong), playable by the singers, are available from the composer.
